## BAND - 601

Prerequisites: 2 years experience in band or special permission of Director. Attend summer band camp yearly

Length of Course: 2 semesters

Credit: 1/2

Course Fee: \$25.00

For: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

Description: Various activities in the Band are marching band, concert band, pep band, stage band, and majorettes. The Band makes various trips during the year including all football games, solo/ensemble, and concert band contest. Participation in these events is part of the 9 weeks grade.

## ART I - 611

Prerequisites: None

Length of Course: 1 semester

Credit: 1/2

Course Fee: \$10.00

For: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

Description: This is an introductory course in art that focuses on the "Five Elements of Art" (line, shape, texture, color, and value) and the Principles of Design with projects that hit on most, if not all, of the five elements. Watercolor techniques, linoleum printing, contour line drawing from life that emphasizes the sighting method are the main focuses of this course.

## ART II - 612

Prerequisites: Art I

Length of Course: 1 semester

Credit: 1/2

Course Fee: \$10.00

For: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

Description: A continual study of the elements of art and also the principles of design. Projects include: drawing from life, charcoal portraits, colored pencil techniques, exposure to art history, class critiques, acrylic painting, clay hand building, and sculpture.

## ADVANCED ART - 613

Prerequisites: Art I and Art II

Length of Course: 1 semester

Credit: 1/2

Course Fee: \$10.00

For: Grades 10, 11, 12

Description: A continual study of the elements of art and principles of design. Focus will be on more creative aspects of art using computer technology. This course will also require more advanced drawing projects, ceramics work, and artist research projects.

## CHORUS - 602

Prerequisites: 8th grade Chorus or with permission of instructor

Length of Course: 2 semesters (meets 5 times weekly)

Credit: 1/2

Course Fee: \$10.00

For: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

Description: This course offers opportunity for all students to participate in a musical group. It is designed to enrich the cultural background of the student and to provide an opportunity for each individual to find a satisfying experience through both listening and participating. The Chorus is active during the winter giving concerts and participating in contests and festivals. Participation in these events is part of the 9 weeks grade. Students with desire and ability as solo performers are encouraged to participate in fall variety program, Christmas musical and at various community functions during the school year. One of the most rewarding experiences that a chorus member is offered is participation in the spring musical when he/she may gain knowledge not only musically, but in acting, stage design, publicity, make-up, costuming, lighting, etc.
